As PCC&MEC have practical experience on relief and rehabilitation activities in several years during disaster period, so PCC&MEC feels to prepare a disaster policy.

Reviving this, PCC&MEC have prepared this Disaster Management Policy covering January 2006 to December 2008 with the objective of the policy is access of adequate survival supports, rehabilitation supports and post flood supports who are suffering in disasters. The policy contents are ; Goal of the Policy, Purpose, Formation of Disaster Management Committee, Information Collection, Prioritization of problems and needs to be addressed, Plan of Relief Supports, Rescue Operation, Ware House, Relief Distribution, Rehabilitation, Liaison with Govt. and Local Administration, Relief and Rehabilitation Strategy, contents and price of survival package for 15 days of a single family, Disaster Preparedness and Contingency Budgeting, Food/Disaster affected information .etc.

I am giving my heartfelt gratitude to the staffs concerns whose efforts are getting these results as a policy paper on Disaster Management Policy.

## **1. Introduction:**

### **Background of PCC&MEC:**

**PCC&MEC**, as a Non-profit Voluntary Social Development Organization, established in 1985 with the initiative of a group of educated social workers of Khulna. Since its inception, it has been working for the human and socio-economic development of the poor and disadvantaged people particularly women and children at grass-roots level.

At present **PCC&MEC** has undertaken different development program for making the targeted people particularly women and children capable, self sufficient and self-initiators by building capacity, institution, capital and utilization of local resources.

- To come up with innovative project designs and ideas to address these multidimensional social issues in the context of Bangladesh.
- To facilitate innovative and practical ICT tools that will aid these development activities
- To share management expertise and know-how with partner organizations in order to facilitate coordinated development efforts
- Make ensure of children's rights in projects and programs in respect of gender issues for bringing equal rights and opportunities.
- To provide constructive consultancy and organizational expertise to the partner organizations and clients
- To actively work as a complementary force alongside the government initiatives of Bangladesh, by obliging to the legal regulations of the Government of Bangladesh.

### **Climate history of Bangladesh:**

Bangladesh has a tropical monsoon -type climate, with a hot and summer and a dry winter. January a the coolest month with temperatures averaging near 26 deg C (78 d F) and April the warmest with temperatures from 33 to 36 deg C (91 to 96 deg F).The climate is one of the wettest in the world. Most places receive more than 1525mm of rain a year, and areas near hills receive 5085 mm. Most rains occur during the monsoon (June-September) and little in winter (November- February).

Bangladesh is subject to devastating cyclones, originating over the Bay of Bengal, in the periods of April to May and September to November. Often accompanied by surging waves, these storms can cause great damage and loss of life. The cyclone of November 1970, in which about 500,000 lives were lost in Bangladesh, was one of the worst natural disasters of the country in the 20<sup>th</sup> Century.

Bangladesh has warm temperatures throughout the year, with relatively little variation from month to month. January tends to be the coolest month and May the warmest. In Dhaka the average January temperature is about 19 deg (about 66 deg F) and the average May temperature is about 29 deg C ( about 84 deg.F).

The average rainfall varies from a maximum of 5690mm in the northeast of the country to minimum of 1110mm in the west. The ground water however provides adequate storage of to compensate for annual variation in rainfall and stream flow. The average annual discharge from the three major rivers -a total of 3500 cusec is second only to the Amazon. The carry billions of tons of sediments loads every year.

As it is situated in tropics, the country is prone to cyclones associated with tidal surges, especially in the pre-monsoon and post monsoon months. Because of high density of population in the flood deltaic coastal region, the loss of human life in such cyclones has at times been very heavy.

The country experiences a hot summer of high humidity from late March to late June, a somewhat cooler but still hot and humid monsoon from late June through October and cool dry winter from November to the end of February. Day temperature ranges from 7 to 12 deg C in the cool months and in the other months it varies between 23-30 deg C.

#### **Experience of PCC&MEC:**

**PCC&MEC** have experienced in implementation of flood related activities in 1996, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2004 by the assistance of different donors and its own fund.

In 1996, **PCC&MEC** distributed relief goods among the tornado victim people at Satkhira at Khulna. That time heavy tornado and storm at Satkhira and destroyed more than 2500 households, cattle, crops and other means. **PCC&MEC** at that time gave survival supports like dry foods, shelter, medical supports, clothes and other necessary supports and services.

In 1998 there have floods in the Dacope, Dumuria, Moheskhalia of Chittagong areas affected more than m10000 peoples with their houses, shelters, cattle's, crops and other means. **PCC&MEC** , that time gave survival supports like dry foods, shelter, medical supports, cloths and others necessary supports and services.

In 1999 **PCC&MEC** distributed relief goods among the havoc flood victim people at Dacope Sadar, Sutorkhali, laudob at Dacope. That time flood destroyed houses, crops and others means of more than 8500 families. **PCC&MEC**, that time gave survival supports like dry foods, shelter, medical supports, cloths and others necessary support and services.

In 2000, since, 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept'2000 heavy rainfall and onrush river water causes devastating flood inundated vast area which affected the people with their shelter crops wealth and other life need necessities. The flood affected people became shelter-less and took shelter in School, Colleges, Madarashas, road side on the trees and roof of buildings without necessary food and means. The people of the affected are have ever been experienced such flood because this flood has come from river erosion near by countries. The flood affected the people of Dumuria, Dacope and gradually spreader to the south-western districts in Bangladesh. The flood situation has turn an alarming situation which need immediate survival support for their livelihood. Considering the inclement disaster, **PCC&MEC** conducted with DFID/BPHC for assisting among the flood affected people. DFID/BPHC took this as seriously and came forward for help. Initially DFID/BPHC grant assistant among 1000 people of Sutarkhali with 15 days food in the 1<sup>st</sup> time and after distributing the foods to the people another grant with dry food and accessories distributed among another 1000 families. After completion of emergency relief activities, DFID/BPHC extent their rehabilitation support for the most destroyed people who have lost their all means. Workers of **PCC&MEC** tried their best to fulfill the Programme activities.

In 2000, **PCC&MEC** also got assistance from CARE-Bangladesh. CARE- Bangladesh provided relief supports more than 60000 families along with survival packages, safe water, foods, cloths, polithene, candle etc in the Sutarkhali and Laudob of Khulna, all Unions of Dumuria under Khulna district. Besides those **PCC&MEC** also got relief and rehabilitation supports from CDD, Handicap-International, CIDA etc.

The devastating and terrible flood 2004 which occurred and has inundated the 42 districts of Bangladesh which pave a great lost of 4 crore people including damage of their wealth, shelter, crops, livestock's, necessary foods and all means. The number of victims people of

the flood area are so a high that relief goods need more people in the victim area. People in the remote area of Faridpur district are also suffering of relief goods. Local GoB and other organization has distributed relief goods among the flood victims people as on their capability which are not enough to meet the need of the flood affected people. So, to meet the needs of suffering people of Faridpur district, **PCC&MEC** distributed relief among the victim peoples.

**Details Disaster Policy:**

As **PCC&MEC** have practical experience on relief and rehabilitation activities in several years during disaster period, so **PCC&MEC** feels to prepare a disaster policy . Details of the policy are given below:

**Goal of the Policy:**

Save people from disasters their shelter, rehabilitations and means.

**Purpose:**

Access of adequate survival supports, rehabilitation supports and post flood supports who are suffering in disasters.

**Activities:**

**Formation of Disaster Management Committee:**

As Bangladesh is disaster prone are, so **PCC&MEC** have formed a Disaster Management Committee as follows:

- Convener: Executive Director
- Member: Deputy Executive Director
- Director,Program
- Deputy Director,Program
- Finance Coordinator
- Medical Officer
- Admin. Officer
- Program Coordinators

The committee will seat together for liaison and maintenance the activities.

**Information Collection:**

Information will be collected through observation, Medias, other secondary sources like Peoples Representatives, Government statistics and departments, local leaders, Baseline Survey, household Survey by own workers etc.

**Prioritization of problems and needs to be addressed:**

After collecting information, worst sufferer areas to be prioritize for need based support.

**Plan of Relief Supports:**

Disaster Management Committee will prepare a contingency plan after getting necessary information's. This plan would covered area prioritize, activities ,manpower involve, training to manpower, procurement of goods, seeking donors, resource mobilization by creating own fund collecting local donation, National and international donors, Networks, GoB etc.

**Rescue Operation:**

After getting information rescue operation with help of government and others peoples, private agencies would be involved in safe places.

**Ware House:**

**PCC&MEC** has a minimum DMR fund for emergency relief supports to the victimized peoples. Ware houses at central level and concern area level would be opened for distribution and maintain emergency materials. All the necessary materials would be kept in the ware houses.

**Relief Distribution:**

Necessary Survival packages may be dry food, cloths, shelter, water, medical supports and other means to be distributed among the sufferers. Relief distribution priorities will be women, children, disable, pregnant and lactating mothers, elderly people, orphanage.

**Rehabilitation Supports:**

After relief supports, rehabilitation supports like shelters, sanitation, agriculture, medical treatment, road maintenance, reconstruction of infrastructures, safe drinking water, employment opportunity etc would be give as on needs.

**Liaison with Govt. and Local Administration:**

**PCC&MEC** will make liaison and coordination with Government and different stakeholders for proper management of relief and rehabilitation activities.

**Reporting and Recording:**

All the performed activities would be covered proper recording and reporting and will send to the concern donors, govt. authority and others.
